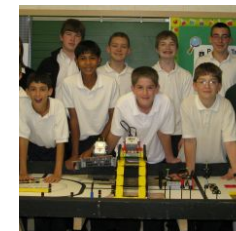

EDUCATION

The school, with an enrollment of over 460 students, is one of the largest Catholic schools in the Rockford diocese. Programs are offered from pre-school through eighth grade, including computer classes in grades K-8, accelerated math classes in grades 6-8 for high school advanced placement, and a fully equipped library, science, and art lab.

In addition to basic academic subjects, Holy Angels offers advanced technology (wi-fi, full-time technology lab, iPads, projectors, Elmos, Smart Boards, and a Qwizdom systems.)

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

While adhering to the highest standards for its curriculum, Holy Angels offers enrichment programs that include: Stanford program (Math), Robotics (Engineering), and Spanish. Other after school programs include, Engineering club, Math club, Newspaper, Drama, Kids club, Homework club, Rainbows, Choir, Band, Young Rembrandts, and Chess. Students can also choose to showcase their projects at H.A.'s annual Science Fair, History Fair, and Fine Arts Fair. Projects from the science fair and history fair advance to the regional level and capture top honors at the state level.

SPORTS

Two athletic directors provide a physical education program for students K-8. In addition, Holy Angels has one of the largest sports programs in the area offering 5-8th grade Volleyball, Basketball, Track, Football, Soccer, and Cheerleading.

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Holy Angels offers a full time counselor and a nurse on site to provide students support they need while at school. Academically, Holy Angels also has an instructional intervention team and a reading specialist for students who require extra help.

SAFETY

Holy Angels takes student safety very seriously and has implemented cameras at all entrances, locked doors/ buzz entry system, safety drills, a policeman assigned to school, and works directly with APD, AFD, and Kane County to maintain strict safety standards.
